DID YOU KNOW

The logistics behind a city's fireworks display require a massive, highly regulated supply chain. Because fireworks are classified as 1.3G or 1.4G explosives, moving them requires specialized hazardous materials (HAZMAT) transport, strict Department of Transportation (DOT) compliance, and precise inventory tracking. The American Pyrotechnics Association (APA) notes that the U.S. imports over 400 million pounds of fireworks annually for both display and consumer use. Coordinating the transport from overseas factories to local distribution hubs, and finally to thousands of staging sites across the country all for one single night of synchronized events, is a masterclass in modern logistics.
